## God Is & Is Known :: Existence and Knowability

### We know God and that He is because ...

- ... God shows us through His creation wonder of the world around us Romans 1
- ... God shows us through our conscience —universal moral law within us Romans 2
- ... God shows us through His Word → Christ written & Resurrected Words given to us Romans 3

**Excursus**: Arguments for God's Existence are Evidences of God's Reality The Christian Life is an apologetic to then clarify along life's way: 1 Peter 3:15

#### ... God shows us through his creation - the wonder of the world around us

Cosmological Argument: From the necessary cause of the universe

Teleological Argument: From the Intelligent Design of the world. Purposeful Fine-Tuning.

Ontological Argument: God *is*; "that than which no greater can be conceived"

#### ... God shows us through our conscience - universal moral law within us

Moral Argument: No God, no universal grounding for morality — no right, no wrong

- (1) If God does not exist, objective moral values and duties do not exist.
- (2) Objective moral values and duties do exist.
- (3) Therefore, God exists





# THREE FOUNDATIONS-




# THREE ERRORS



Modalism claims that there is one person who appears to us in three different forms or modes.



Subordinationism claims that the Son and Holy Spirit are subordinate to the Father in nature and being.



Tritheism denies that there is only one God and instead claims that there are three Gods.
